There will be a separate category for Shodans. The top two ranked Shodans will join the Nidan and up eliminations.

Each competitor may only participate in one team kata.

Judges: Gray pants, white shirt, JKA burgundy tie, please bring your own whistle.

Coaches: JKA Canada or US jacket recommended.

Hand protectors: ONLY white, thin, and conservative. Mouth guard (clear or white): mandatory for free sparring for brown and black belts. No shin guards nor arm protection. Groin protection recommended.

Hair: tied back (male & female). Nails: short. No glasses, jewelry, body piercing ornaments, verbal retaliation.

Keep your gi and belt on at all times on the gymnasium floor. Lower your voices, others are competing.

Please silence your phone, step outside to take your calls.

- 2:15 PM Judges and officials arrive
- 2:30 PM Judges conference
- 3:00 PM Tournament starts for white, yellow, orange, green, blue, and purple belts (9–4 Kyu)
- 6:00 PM Anticipated end of white to purple belt events

Sunday, March 8

- 9:00 AM Competitor check-in starts for brown and black belts (bring JKA passports for stamps). Balcony opens for spectators.
- 9:15 AM Judges and officials arrive
- 9:30 AM Judges conference
- 10:00 AM Tournament starts for brown and black belts (3–1 Kyu & Dan)
- 4:00 PM Anticipated end of tournament and clean up

* FEBRUARY 15: REGISTRATION DEADLINE

Events description:

1. Kata: A sequence of movements students are learning in class (Taikyoku 1, Heian 1–5, Tekki, etc.)
2. Kumite: Partner work, includes combinations that students are practicing in class (3-step, 1-step, Semifree sparring (Jiyu Ippon), Free sparring (2-minute Shobu Ippon))
3. Team kata: A three-competitor team performing synchronized kata (multi-age)
Note: Only some competitors will be prepared for team katas. The three names on each team must be given on February 15 or as soon after. Each competitor may only participate in one team kata.

Fee: \$30 (Age 8–17) or \$40 (Age 18 or older) for 1, 2 or 3 events

Fees must be paid before February 15, 2026

Competitors will be divided into rank (e.g.: intermediate and advanced white belts, yellow, orange, green, blue, purple, brown, and black) and age (approximate age groups: 8–11, 12–17, adults 18+) categories for individual kata and kumite events. Each competitor is registered automatically in both individual kata and individual kumite, unless requested otherwise. A clean white uniform will be required for tournament day. Competitors should bring a snack, sweatshirt, socks, and a water bottle. Hair: tied back (male & female). Nails: short. No glasses, jewelry, body piercing ornaments, verbal retaliation. Do not dress or undress in the gym. Keep your belt on. Flat white hand protectors and a mouth guard are required for all competitors in Shobu Ippon kumite.

Quiet in the gym and the balcony please. Lower your voices please, others are competing. Please silence your phone, step outside to take your calls. No flash nor video light in competitors' eyes. Please remain seated to not block the view of others.

Parents: Please welcome your neighbors from other clubs in the balcony. NO running in the center.

Spectators: Tickets are sold for \$5 at the door.
